Dear Child Care Partner,

Thank you for providing care for families participating through the FMYN's Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) program. I am excited to announce that through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), FMYN is awarding stabilization subgrants for childcare providers who meet eligibility requirements. You are an eligible provider as defined by ARPA if your program is either:

Licensed, regulated or registered as of March 11, 2021, and met state and local health and safety requirements as of the date of application.

OR

Meets CCDF eligibility and meets all CCDF health and safety requirements, including the completion of a comprehensive background check.

Subgrant funds can be spent on the following categories: personnel costs, rent, utilities, facilities maintenance, insurance, PPE, cleaning, equipment, supplies, goods, services, and other qualified expenses (see attached FAQ document for more information).

The following forms are required to be submitted as part of the application packet:

- ARPA-CCDF Stabilization Subgrant Application
- New Vendor Form
- W9 Form
